### Who we are

Arts and Health South West (AHSW) is a registered charity based in the UK. We are a free membership organisation, funded by Arts Council England. (Registered Charity number 1115339, company limited by guarantee number 5420987.)

### What we do

We use our website to promote news, opportunities, events, networking information and evidence about arts and health initiatives.

We are also a free membership organisation: when people sign up as a member we send them information through our email newsletter or “e-bulletin” once a month, and through occasional “newsflash” emails.

These emails contain news and updates about arts and health work in the South West, across the UK and internationally, including information about the arts and health conferences that we run each year and fundraising campaigns we occasionally run to support arts and health work.

### What data is collected from you when you use our website.

This document explains how and for what purposes we use the information collected about you via our website, <http://www.ahsw.org.uk>.

By using our website and any services we offer via our website, you are agreeing to be bound by this policy in respect of the information collected about you via this website.

#### 1. Information automatically collected from your computer

- Log files/IP addresses: When you visit the Site Google Analytics automatically records your IP address which it makes available to AHSW.
- Google Analytics may also gather other non-personal information (from which we cannot identify you) such as the type of your internet browser, which AHSW may use to provide you with a more effective service.

## **2. Cookies**

- This site uses session-cookies only, and only so that logged-in AHSW Members can move around the site without their session timing out and so being repeatedly asked to log in again. Session-cookies are destroyed whenever you close your browser down, and those on this site do not store any identifiable or sensitive personal data.
- AHSW Members will need to enable cookies (if only for this site) in order to get the best use from it.
- Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings.
